

Paola City Code

Section 200.010: Animals at Large

"It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation owning, harboring or having in custody any domestic or wild animal to permit the same to run at large within the City or to picket the same upon any public property of the City."

Section 200.070: Registration and license required - tax

"It shall be the duty of every owner or harboring or any dog or dogs within the limits of the City to cause each dog or dogs to be registered and to pay the tax as provided in this Article and obtain a license from the City Clerk."

Section 200.080: Owner or Harboring defined (basically says after 10 consecutive days you are the owner or harboring)

Section 200.090: Dogs Exempt (dogs under 6 months are exempt from licensing provisions)

Section 200.100: Annual Tax

1. Neutered, male or female \$5.00
2. Unneutered, male or female \$10.00

Section 200.110: Tax Period (due and payable on January 2nd yearly)

Section 200.140: Running at large of Dogs

"It shall be unlawful for the owner, keeper or harboring or any person having the care, custody or control of any dog to permit such dog to run at large within the City or to trespass upon the private grounds of any person except the owner, harboring or keeper. Any person convicted of violating..."

Cats basically the same things apply, just different Section #s. There is more, like they have to have current rabies vaccine, impounding of animals, etc.
